# 1. INTRODUCTION

This Cookie Policy explains how Kronisys Inc. ("Company," "we," "us," or "our") uses cookies and similar tracking technologies when you visit our website or use our services. #### 2. WHAT ARE COOKIES

**Cookies** are small text files that are placed on your device (computer, smartphone, tablet) when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work more efficiently and to provide information to website owners about user behavior and preferences.

#### Cookies typically contain:

- The name of the website from which the cookie has come
- The "lifetime" of the cookie (how long it will remain on your device)
- A unique identifier or other data

### 3. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

We use different types of cookies for various purposes. Below is a detailed breakdown of the categories of cookies we employ:

### 3.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting and reporting information anonymously:

#### 3.3 Functional Cookies

These cookies enable enhanced functionality and personalization:

## 11. DATA RETENTION

Cookie data is retained for different periods depending on the type and purpose:

Cookie Category	Typical Retention Period
Session Cookies	Until browser session ends
Functional Cookies	30 days to 1 year
Analytics Cookies	26 months (Google Analytics default)
Marketing Cookies	30 days to 2 years
